#### People who Like to Teach or Interact with Others

- **9-1-1 Dispatcher:** 9-1-1 dispatchers are responsible for receiving incoming calls, prioritizing calls based on the nature of the emergency, providing instructions on lifesaving emergency medical interventions, and dispatching the proper emergency personnel.
- **Political Representative:** Our speaker is an elected representative who helps set goals and policies. They help oversee an annual budget and advocate on behalf of their constituents.
